CAN YOU TRULY SEE?

One day Jesus came across a man who was blind. He had been born blind. He had never looked at his own hand, wondered at fingerprints, watched his fingers flex, and cleaned the dirt from under his fingernails. The man was on the side of the street begging.

Night is coming," Jesus says to his disciples as they pause, "but I am the light of the world."

And then Jesus, ever compassionate, kneels down. The blind man doesn't know what is happening. He hears someone scratching in the earth and then spitting. Suddenly he feels Jesus' finger gently touching his closed eyes, covering his eyelids with warm, moist mud. What is this? "Go wash in the Pool of Siloam," Jesus tells him, and helps him to his feet. The pool is close, so he makes his way down the cobbled street, one hand carefully feeling along a wall, the other stretched out into the darkness beyond. "So the man went and washed," the Bible records, "and came home seeing."

Imagine it. Your son open the front door, and walks into the living room. "Mom," he shouts, "I can see." Tears stream down his face as he embraces his mother. She calls out to her neighbors, "My Son can see! He can see!"

Who is this one who heals? Who is this one who kneels next to a blind man and gently touches his eyes? Who is he?


A few days later Jesus approaches Simon on the street. "Do you believe in the Son of God?" Jesus asks.

Simon remembers that voice and the words, I am the Light of the World. He looks up — for the first time — into the Master's face. "Who is he? Tell me so that I may believe in him."

"You now behold him," Jesus says. "He is the one speaking with you." "Lord, I believe," says Simon, and drops to his knees in worship. Some self-righteous Pharisees sneer at the Master and the man kneeling in the dust. Jesus looks their direction. "For judgment I have come into this world," he says, "so that the blind will see, and those who see will become blind. If you were blind, you would not be guilty of sin, but now that you claim you can see, your guilt remains." Interesting. The blind see, and the self-righteous become blind.

Which are you? One who has walks about in darkness for much of your life, just now beginning to glimpse the Light of the World? Or one of the self-righteous, sneering cynics, who wouldn't recognize God's Son if he were standing in front of your eyes?

THE POWER OF WORDS



One important reason to WATCH WHAT YOU SAY is that words have power. Proverbs 15:4 says: "A calm tongue is a tree of life, but twisted speech causes despair."* Even as water revives a thirsty tree, so the calm speech of a soothing tongue can refresh the spirit of those hearing it. In contrast, the twisted words of a perverse tongue can crush the spirit of others. Indeed, the words we speak have the power to injure or to heal.—Proverbs 18:21.

Vividly describing the power of words, another proverb says: "Thoughtless speech is like the stabs of a sword." (Proverbs 12:18) Thoughtless words said in haste can cause deep emotional wounds and destroy relationships. Has your heart ever been pierced by the thrusts of a verbal sword? On the positive side, the same proverb says: "The tongue of the wise is a healing."

Thoughtful words from one who manifests godly wisdom can mend an aching heart and restore relationships. Can you recall an occasion when you experienced the healing power of kind words? (Read Proverbs 16:24.)

Recognizing that spoken words have power, we certainly want to use our speech to heal others, not to hurt them.

No matter how hard we try, we cannot completely control our tongue. Here, then, is a second reason why we need to WATCH WHAT WE SAY: Sin and imperfection incline us toward misusing our tongue. Words are a product of our heart, and "the inclination of the heart of man is bad." (Genesis 8:21; Luke 6:45) Keeping a rein on our tongue is therefore a real struggle. (Read James 3:2-4.) Although we cannot gain perfect control of our tongue, we can keep working at making improvement in how we use it. Just as a swimmer trying to swim upstream has to keep fighting the current, so we have to keep fighting the sinful tendency to misuse our tongue.

Hebrews 12:1

"Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God." (KJV)

Life can hit us hard. Sometimes you get knocked down when you don't even see it coming.

You are not defined by what happens to you, but rather by how you react to what happen to you. When you get hit, do you stay down? Or do you reach down somewhere deep inside of yourself and pull up the courage that lifts you back on your feet to **keep moving forward**?

God does not want us to look backwards, he does not want us to go through life looking in the rear view mirror. But we so often can't help ourselves.

It's time to look ahead and focus on what's before us. God wants to do a new things in our lives. He wants us to rise up to our full potential in Him. He has called us to do great things.

We have got to **keep on moving forward**. It's only in moving forward that we ever accomplish what God has called us to. We can't stay where we're at, nor can we go backwards. The only direction we can go is forward. Yes, it can be hard – but it's the only way if we want to move on in God and grow.

Many times our faith is tested by things that occur in our lives. Something's can be so devastating to you and you start to question why God or any other entity would allow this to happen to you. Keep the faith to know that you are not alone in your struggles for we are all fighting some type of battle in our lives...simply because we are all human and no one is perfect. Some of us are just better at covering it up then others. In order to move forward, you need a firm foundation to step from. By understanding what and where you want to go in life will provide your vision and spirit, it will give you your foundation to **keep moving forward**.

Open your heart and trust that everything in this life, no matter what it is happens for a reason. Faith is having the courage to deal with the problem you are facing your life. Faith believes that there is a greater good and things will get better. Even though it may seem unlikely, or even impossible, faith is what can pull you through.

Through it all at the end of the day you must maintain Faith...honor it....cherish it but most of all believe in it for its Faith that will deliver you to wherever you want to go in life. When we lose our ability to, we can easily be physically alive but spiritually dead. 
