Pastor's Reflections **Lastor**'s Kellections

BELIEVING IN JESUS....

There was a man who specialized in riding a bicycle on a tightrope across waterfalls. He set up his equipment across Niagara Falls as a great crowd gathered to watch him ride across the roaring waters. Not only did he complete the trip over, but he returned riding backwards! The crowd was in awe of his ability. He recognized this and asked the crowd, "Do you believe I could do it again with a person sitting on my shoulders?" "Yes," they all shouted as one. He then asked the crowd: Which one of you will ride with me then?"

Before I finish the story, what would you do in that situation? You just witnessed him perform

this task, you know he can do it. But there is a rather large difference between sitting on the side line and watching him risk everything vs. going out on the wire with him and risking everything yourself. If he fell while you were watching, that would be terrible. If he fell while you were on the wire with him that would be tragic. So when he asked, "Which one of you will ride with me then? No one spoke up. I understand that. I might risk my life for something important. I might run into a burning building to try and save someone. But risking my life for something trivial, like walking a tight rope across Niagara Falls seems a bit crazy.

This story made me think about being a Christ-follower. There were people watching who believed he could do it. But there wasn't anyone who believed enough to risk it. That's the difference between believing **about** Jesus and believing **in** Jesus.

When we believe in Jesus, we must trust our whole life to him. We can't just sit back and watch. We have to trust everything to him. Even if it seems incredibly risky to do so.

There are going to be times when it's going to seem risky to turn down the job that wants you to do something against your beliefs, because you really need the work and money. There are going to be times when forgiving is going to seem risky, because that person is going to do something to hurt you, or embarrass, or damage you. There are many ways that following God's plan in our lives can seem risky.

In Deuteronomy 6:5 (NKJV) the Bible tells us "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.." This is repeated many times in the Bible. In our day we hear many people ask do you believe, do you have faith?" Not just sitting and saying I believe in Jesus, but actively putting your life and affairs in his care and trusting him with everything.

"But those who hope in the LORD shall renew their strength. They shall soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint"

(Isaiah 40:31 NKJV).

For the past couple of weeks, I've been taking quizzes that interest me to see what they say about me. Although I've taken many of these quizzes I do know they are for fun and not capable of truly identifying anyone's personality. But it makes me think for a moment about the ways in which we obtain our identity in life. If we are not careful, we can allow many things of the world to mold or shape us. Music, television, work or even hobbies, all tend to affect our lives. The bible tells us "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (Romans 12:2 NKJV)

So he might be telling us, among other things, that we should seek our identity from God. After all, he created us and knows us best. So what does God say about us? I encourage you to grab your Bible and find out. Here are a couple verses which speak to me:

- "I have crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me. (Galatians 2:20 NKJV).
- "But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;" (1 Peter 2:9 NKJV).
- "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. (John 1:12, 13 NKJV).





Sometimes God closes doors because it's time to MOVE forward. He knows you won't move unless your circumstances force you to move.


